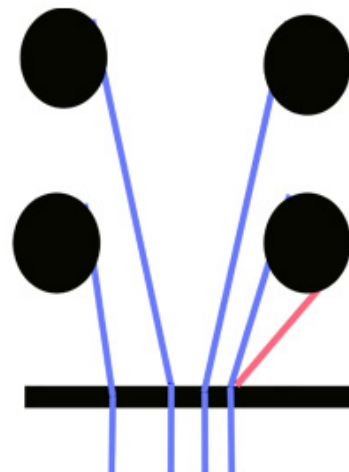
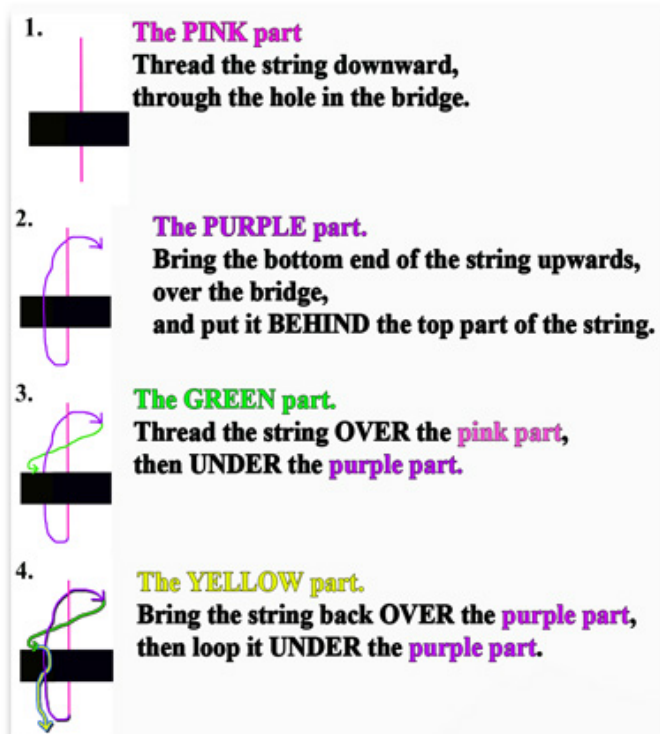
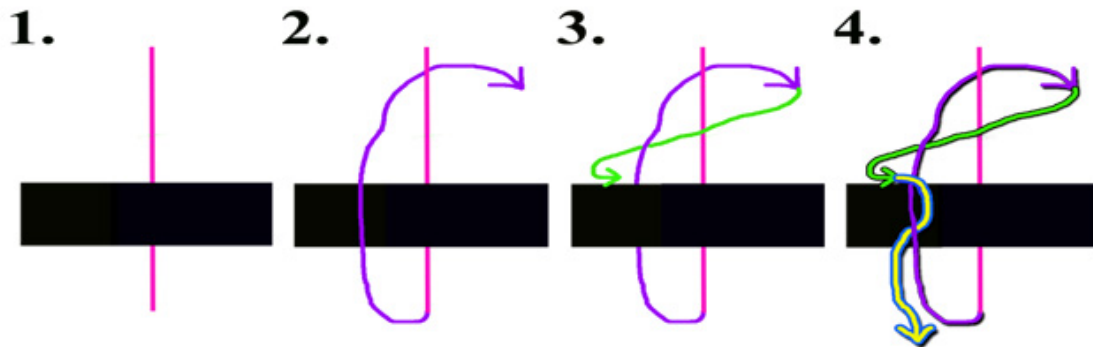


Bartt's String-Changing Lesson

Blue: Good

Red: Bad

*Wind the strings from the **INSIDE** of the post, and wrap them so they're moving towards the outside of the headstock. Like the **blue** strings pictured here. Not like the **red** string.*

After you've completed these steps, grab both ends of the string simultaneously and tug them apart, to tighten the knot. Then bring the long loose end of the string up to the tuning peg, loop it through the hole in the post, and hold it in place while turning the peg. After a couple of turns, the string should stay in place and you can finish tuning.

Wrap the string around the post, so that the wrapped part is **ABOVE** the string. This will help your string stay in tune, because the pressure from the wrapping will keep the string in place
