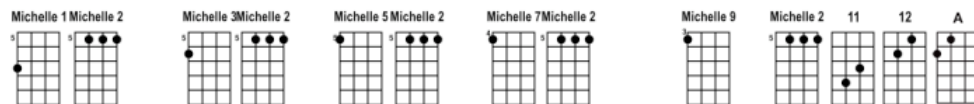
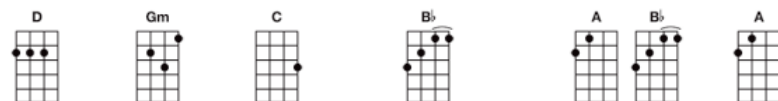

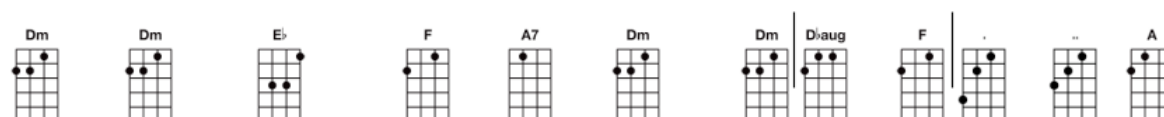
Intro: Play the bass note with your thumb, then pluck the other notes of the chord simultaneously with your fingers



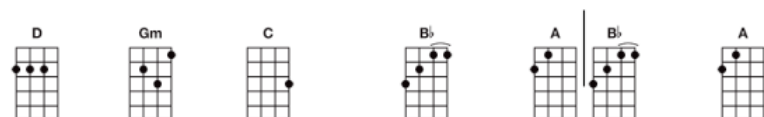
